15th Nordic Demographic Symposium

The Danish Demographic Society hereby announces the 15th Nordic Demographic Symposium, and invites all interested persons to participate in the Symposium, which will convene from 28 – 30 April 2005 in Aalborg.

Aalborg is the fourth largest city in Denmark and situated at the Limfjord in North Jutland. All sessions will be held at Aalborg University, AAU, which was inaugurated in 1974 as the fifth Danish university. The conference site at the University is located a few kilometers outside the city of Aalborg. In 2004, AAU has more than 13,000 students.

Papers

Written papers are optional. When you register for participation please indicate whether you wish to present a paper (only orally or/and also in written form) and give the title of the session and of your paper.

Deadline for submission of preliminary abstracts is 1 September 2004.

Language

The languages of the symposium will primarily be the Nordic ones, but English language may be used in presentations and discussions if preferred by the session leader and the participants in a session. The decision on which languages to be used will preferably be taken before the symposium and the session leader will inform the presenters about the decision.

At the website, which will be currently updated, you can find more information about the conference program, sessions and accommodation. You are supposed to arrange accommodation by yourself.
